In February Kejora received 300+ books from the Qahal Foundation in Wonogiri. This included many Christian books, some of which were donated to, and warmly received by the local Church in Karimunjawa. Last month 100+ English books arrived from the UK, kindly donated by Josje Branum de Haas and Rebecca Shaw, and shipped by House Music Group. As our library continues to grow with more books and laptops, we are making plans to hold book reading events, parent and child reading mornings, as well as literacy and computer skill workshops.
