The past few weeks, we at Kejora have been very busy building on the next step in our programs. Because of your donation, we want to inform you of all recent developments, so you get a picture of what we have done with all of the donations we have received so far.

Kejora PLAY Basecamp

Finally it's here! The past few weeks we have been hard at work building our basecamp. It's been built on the edge of the forest, the materials consisting mostly of wood and bamboo, and the location has been chosen to give children the room and freedom to play in a safe, natural environment.



On the 6th of June, the Basecamp will be opened with appropriate festivities, after which we will start offering the first activities. This includes an educational playgroup for children between the ages of 3 and 6, where bilingual education takes centre stage. The children will be encouraged to develop cognitively, physically, socially, and emotionally, while connecting with different cultures as well as nature, through playful learning programs led by professional local teachers, the curriculum in keeping with international guidelines for development.



Kejora PLAY Beach

Some children are not able to join us for the educational playgroup at our basecamp. For those kids, we offer an engaging program every Sunday, located on the beach. Here too, the connection with nature, through the sand and the sea, is emphasised.

This program is offered bilingually, and the participation fee is intentionally kept as low as possible, so all kids on Karimunjawa are financially able to join the program.



Kejora PLAY Alun-Alun

Every Saturday evening, we offer a playground for all kids to enjoy at the Alun-Alun square. We have, for example, a trampoline and a bouncy castle, and children can get their face painted.

By asking for a little bit of compensation for certain activities, we can offer kids a fun Saturday evening, while maintaining a weekly income that helps us afford our more intensive programs.



Donations

We are infinitely grateful for every donation we have received so far. These have mostly been used for building our basecamp, and getting equipment to flesh out the Alun-Alun playground. What we want to buy next are teaching materials, such as instruments, sports equipment, and art supplies.
